The opening page of the first registration form is in Norwegian. You have to accept the first question in Norwegian as shown below to get to the form in English. If a red **x** appears, you have to make sure all the details are filled in before you can go on to the next page of the registration. Please do not pay attention to any pop-ups in Norwegian. See the guide for registration.

Registration **and** pay before Mai1.

Limits: 5 persons per city farm preliminary. We will open the registration for more people after May 1. if necessary

How to get to the conference:

Your destination is **Bodø** in the county of Nordland, just above the Arctic circle (The city is called *Bådåddjo* in sami language)

By flight from Gardermoen/Oslo: www.norwegian.no or www.sas.no (75 minutes flight) Aprox150 euro

By train: www.nsb.no (17- 18 hours) Tickets approx 50-100 euro Oslo-Bodø

By car: aprox 1500 km from Oslo

Coastal steamer goes from **Bergen** to Bodø. (35 hours) www.hurtigruten.no The most beautiful voyage in the world according to National Geographic. Quite expensive, however nice to combine with train one way or another

Believe it or not: In Bodø it's **walking** distance from the railway station, airport and harbour to the hotel

Extended stay? If you come before June 20, or stay after June 24, you have to find your own accommodation

Weather: normally 92 mm of rain in June. Avg. temperature is + 15 C. Coastal and windy area. Bring summer clothing, warm sweaters, raincoats, good shoes for walking, t-shirts and sandals if the weather forecast is very good.

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Car transport if anyone needs for Friday 21, as we do some walking this day and you may not be fit for 30-60 minutes of walking? Ask for this in the registration form

Alcohol: use of alcohol in outdoor events is not allowed in Norway. You will be served coffee, tea, juice etc with all the outdoor meals except for midsummer eve. Alcohol is also expensive compared to the rest of Europe, 5 Euro for a pint of beer in pubs, 3 Euro in shops. 13-20 Euro for a bottle of wine, only sold at the liquor store.

Currency: In Norway you use Norwegian kroner only. 1 Euro is approx 8 kroner
